The Blue Eyes, Big Heart Scholarship was created in memory of Joshua Alderton, a remarkable young man who tragically passed away in a car accident on July 25, 2013. Josh had a larger than life personality and a passion for volunteering. His charitable spirit truly knew no bounds and the scholarship is intended to help people who have been affected by domestic violence pursue their educational goals. Josh was dedicated to breaking the chain of violence in his own community and we believe that by helping women and children affected by domestic violence pursue higher education we can carry on his legacy.

Scholarship Guidelines

Please review these guidelines prior to completing the application form.

Eligibility:

To be considered for the award you must be

1. A resident Canadian Citizen or landed immigrant
2. Have significant financial need as demonstrated by the application and supporting documents.
3. Have been affected by domestic violence and be actively working to break the chain of violence.
4. Applications must be received in the Foundation office by **4 pm May 24th** of any year. If May 24th is a weekend day, the deadline is extended to the following Tuesday. Late applications cannot be considered.

The scholarship is awarded on the understanding that the funds will be used to cover the cost of enrolment in an educational programme or the materials required to complete academic upgrading.

Application Process:

1. All applicants are required to complete the scholarship application form and include all the required documents as listed. The completed application and supporting documents must be sent or delivered to:

2. A letter or email acknowledging the receipt of the completed application will be sent.
3. All applications that include the requested material and that meet the guidelines as outlined above are forwarded for consideration to the BEBH Scholarship Committee
4. The committee recommendation is sent to the SCF board whose decision is final. Those applicants that are declined are informed in writing
5. Successful applicants will be informed in writing with payment to follow and should be available for photos, interviews or any other promotional activities as arranged by the Foundation

INFORMATION TO BE INCLUDED

- Evidence of residency in Lambton County or Chatham –Kent. This could be a copy of a driver’s license, lease agreement or bill. Out of territory residents may be considered depending on the volume of local applications
- TWO letters of recommendation. These must be written on your behalf by someone other than a family member or relative. One should be from an individual qualified to speak on your situation. The second should be from someone who has knowledge of your community involvement and service.
- An essay of up to 1000 words on how domestic violence has affected you and how you hope to break the chain of violence in your life

3. Describe the volunteer positions you have held, including the length of time served.

4. Please describe how, with the competing pressures of school and family life, you plan or currently balance work and fun?
