

To date, the Sarnia Community Foundation has distributed more than \$5 million dollars to local charities and non-profit organizations in need, to make Sarnia Lambton a vibrant, inclusive, livable community.

On Tuesday, September 20, the Sarnia Community Foundation held the Grants and Donor Appreciation night. There were 11 Community Impact grants given totalling \$93,400.00 and 7 Donor advised grants given totalling \$26,000.00 made to local charities.
