



BRIAN FOX Memorial Agricultural Scholarship

In honour of the late Brian Fox, the Ontario Sugarbeet Growers Association (OSGA) established the Brian Fox Memorial Agricultural Scholarship. Brian Fox, who passed away in 2013 was a well respected Chatham-Kent farmer, community leader, innovative businessman, and the founding Chairman of the OSGA. The scholarship fund is managed by the Sarnia Community Foundation on behalf of the OSGA. ALL applications must be received by the Sarnia Community Foundation by the posted deadline.

Scholarship Guidelines.

Eligibility

You must ...

- 1. Have been accepted into an accredited college or university agricultural programme OR already be enrolled and attending an agricultural programme. Your academic record will be considered as part of the application. Students interested in applying must have a minimum GPA Requirement of 2.7 or a high school average of 70% in the top 6 senior classes.
- 2. Be a resident of Chatham Kent or Lambton County.
- 3. Be able to demonstrate active involvement in the agricultural community.
- 4. Have significant financial need as demonstrated in the application document.

Conditions

- 1. Scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the funds will be used to cover the cost of attending a program of studies and may be directed to the academic institution if requested by the winner.
- 2. By signing the application, the applicant agrees to the expectations of scholarship recipients and gives the Sarnia Community Foundation and OSGA permission to publish their name, photo and program All other information will remain confidential.
- 3. Candidates *may be* required to present bank statements and income tax returns in support of their application.
- 4. Recipients must be available for photos, interviews or any other promotional activities as arranged by the Scholarship Committee (e.g. award ceremonies, media interviews, etc.)

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS: 4 pm- November 30th

If the 30th is a weekend day, then deadline is extended to the first business day following

AWARDS will be presented at the OSGA annual meeting in February or March of the following year
